

What is Classroomscreen?

You can combine all the widgets you need to set clear expectations, collect feedback, support your time management, and much more! We believe that Classroomscreen can make teaching more effective and engaging in just a few clicks. You can set visual timers to keep activities on track and use noise level monitors to manage the classroom atmosphere.

Display instructions clearly with the text box, and make lessons interactive with the drawing tool and media embedding. Involve all students by using random name pickers and quickly gauge understanding with polls. Customizing backgrounds and themes also helps create an engaging and relevant learning environment.



Meet the widgets



Your essentials

There are some widgets which we think are essential Classroomscreen tools, so we wanted to take this time to show them off to you in all their glory!

Clock

Where would any teacher be without the Clock? You'll see this widget on pretty much every screen made by our users. Time management an essential part of teaching, so make sure to pop this on your screen to help keep track of the time.

↑. Tip: Want to change from analogue to digital? Just shrink the widget using your cursor until it changes!

Backgrounds

Crisp, clear background images and patterns are a key benefit of Classroomscreen. Just click the background icon and select a picture, gradient or cute illustration to complete your screen. You can also add your own image or even build a slideshow!



Poll

Whether you are measuring student understanding, gathering opinions, or fostering interactive discussions, this free live polling tool empowers you to collect real-time responses. We have three different formats and even live, remote voting included for all users.

**Example: Add a poll widget to your screen, select the True/False format and type in the question 'Sharks are mammals'. Your students can vote from their devices like so!

My favorite widgets are the **text box** - to inform my students of what they need to accomplish during class time, the **timer** - to let my students know how much time they have left to accomplish their assignments, and the **group maker** - to easily place students in groups.


The **Randomizer** widget is a great feature to keep the student on their toes. It's fair and democratic and allows a different child to be selected at random each time for whatever chosen task the teacher has.

Say hi to your Dashboard!

Good organization is central to teaching, so when designing Classroomscreen, we prioritized storage! There is no limit on how many screens you can have as a Pro user, so knowing how to organize your screens effectively is super important.

Your Dashboard is where you can see all your screens and organize them according to your needs. You can access your dashboard by clicking on the 'Home' icon in the upper left-hand corner of your screen. You can also access your name lists, backgrounds and other important settings here.

Workspaces

Dashboard > workspaces > collections > screens

You will see at least one workspace on the left side of the dashboard when using Classroomscreen with no account or a Basic account. If you have a Pro account, you can create additional workspaces.

Workspaces are often used to group screens according to subject or year group.

Collections

Dashboard > workspaces > collections > screens

Collections are a series of screens that can be flicked through. Also, if you choose to 'Pin' a widget, it will be visible in the same location on all screens within that collection.

There are many ways to use the collection, but a common way is to create one collection for each day and store all your screens for that day in the collection.

You can also give each collection a different color to help your organization, and move screens between collections by just dragging your mouse.


Screens form the basis of Classroomscreen - the clue is in the name! There are two ways to create a new screen. You can create a new screen from the dashboard through selecting 'add screen' within a collection overview, or from within an existing screen.


Simply press the right arrow in the bottom-right hand corner of your screen to enter a brand-new one.

Tip: You can also navigate between screens through a handy keyboard shortcut: CNTR + ENTER.




