Classroomscreen is designed to make teaching more effective and engaging with just a few clicks. Use visual timers to keep lessons flowing, and monitor volume levels to create a calm learning space.

Clearly show instructions using the text box, encourage interaction with drawing tools and media, and get every student involved with randomizers and polls. You can also personalize your screen with custom backgrounds and themes to suit your class.

Whilst you can always use Classroomscreen without signing up, there are so many reasons why you should! Just enter your email, set a password, and you are good to go.

We do offer a **Pro** subscription with a bunch of additional features including saving and organizing screens. explore advanced and more functionalities. This Pro subscription also allows you to organize your screens into workspaces, so you can keep all your resources where you need them most.

If you are looking to purchase multiple licenses, make sure to check out our **Organization** option. This allows for an admin to assign a set number of licenses to teachers in the same school or district, saving you both time and money! Reach out to us for a quote.


What does each one do?

Your essentials

There are some widgets which we think are essential Classroomscreen tools, so we wanted to take this time to show them off to you in all their glory!

Clock

Where would any teacher be without a clock? You'll see this widget on pretty much every screen made by our users. Time management an essential part of teaching, so make sure to pop this on your screen to help keep track of the time.

↑. Tip: Want to change from analogue to digital? Just shrink the widget using your cursor until it changes!



Timer


The Timer widget on Classroomscreen helps you manage time with ease. Set countdowns in just a few clicks and choose from digital or visual styles to match your students' needs. Use multiple timers to support smooth transitions, activities, or group work.



Backgrounds

Crisp, clear background images and patterns are a key benefit of Classroomscreen. Just click the background icon and select a picture, gradient or cute illustration to complete your screen.

You can also add your own image or even build a slideshow!



Poll

Whether you are measuring student understanding, gathering opinions, or fostering interactive discussions, this free live polling tool empowers you to collect real-time responses. We have three different formats and even live, remote voting included for all users.

**Example: Add a poll widget to your screen, select the True/False format and type in the question 'Sharks are mammals'. Your students can vote from their devices!





Say hi to your Dashboard!

Good organization is central to teaching, so when designing Classroomscreen, we prioritized storage! There is no limit on how many screens you can have as a Pro user, so knowing how to organize your screens effectively is super important.

Your Dashboard is where you can see all your screens and organize them according to your needs. You can access your dashboard by clicking on the 'Home' icon in the upper left-hand corner of your screen. You can also access your name lists, backgrounds and other important settings here.



Let's explain each tab

Home: This is where you can see all of your screens, sorted into workspaces and collections (we'll dive into those on the next page).

Name lists: This is where all your class lists are stored, to be used in the Group maker and Randomizer widgets. Basic users can store up to 3 name lists, while Pro users can store up to 100.

Backgrounds: If you are a Pro user, you will see all the background images you have uploaded to Classroomscreen. You can upload up to 800 images, so this tab is handy if you need to clear them out occasionally.

Settings: Access your display settings here, such as your language and time format preferences.


Template library: Not sure where to start? Head to our Library of free ready-made screens to get started.

Workspaces

Dashboard > workspaces > collections > screens

You will see at least one workspace on the left side of the dashboard when using Classroomscreen with no account or a Basic account. If you have a Pro account, you can create additional workspaces.

Tip: Workspaces are often used to group screens according to subject or year group.




Collections

Dashboard > workspaces > collections > screens

Collections are a series of screens that can be flicked through. Also, if you choose to 'Pin' a widget, it will be visible in the same location on all screens within that collection.

There are many ways to use the collection, but a common way is to create one collection for each day and store all your screens for that day in the collection. You can also give each collection a different color to help your organization, and move screens between collections by just dragging your mouse.



Screens

Dashboard > workspaces > collections > screens

Screens form the basis of Classroomscreen - the clue is in the name! This is what you will be using in Classroomscreen to display all the tools that you need to keep your class on task.

Your screens can be customized with different backgrounds, widget themes and stickers to suit your teaching style.


Note: While everyone can use Classroomscreen for free, saving your screens is a Pro feature.



Add new screens

There are two ways to create a new screen:

- You can create a new screen from the dashboard through selecting 'add screen' within a collection overview, or from within an existing screen.
- Simply press the right arrow in the bottom-right hand corner of your screen to enter a brand-new one.






Sharing collections

With sharing, you can ensure that students, teachers, and administrators have access to your work when they need it. You can access sharing from different locations in your account, choose what information you wish to share, and modify or disable the permissions of the collections that you've shared.

From the Dashboard


In your dashboard, the sharing feature will be accessible within each collection. Click on the three dots on the top-right corner of a collection and click on 'Share collection' to create your link.





From within a screen

In your current screen, the sharing feature will be accessible for that specific collection. Click on the three dots on the top-right corner of a screen and click on 'Share collection' to create your link.

A pop-up will appear where you can select various settings such as whether to include name lists and images and whether they can make a copy of your screen.




