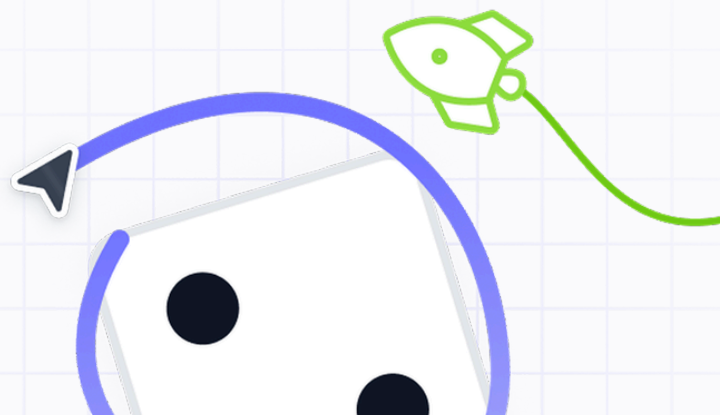

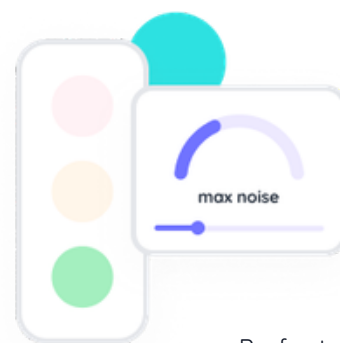

What is Classroomscreen?

You can combine all the widgets you need to set clear expectations, collect feedback, support your time management, and much more! We believe that Classroomscreen can make teaching more effective and engaging in just a few clicks. You can set visual timers to keep activities on track and use noise level monitors to manage the classroom atmosphere.

Display instructions clearly with the text box, and make lessons interactive with the drawing tool and media embedding. Involve all students by using random name pickers and quickly gauge understanding with polls. Customizing backgrounds and themes also helps create an engaging and relevant learning environment.

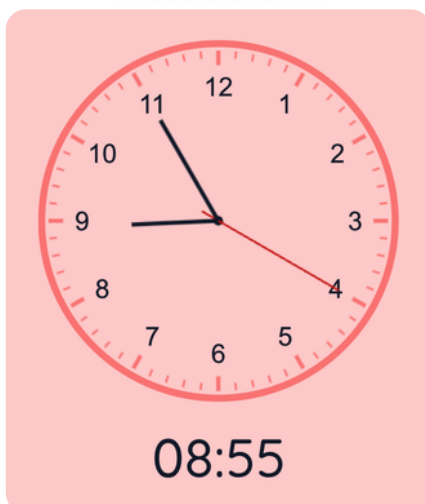
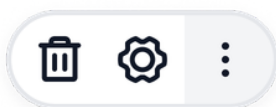


Meet the widgets

Adding and editing widgets

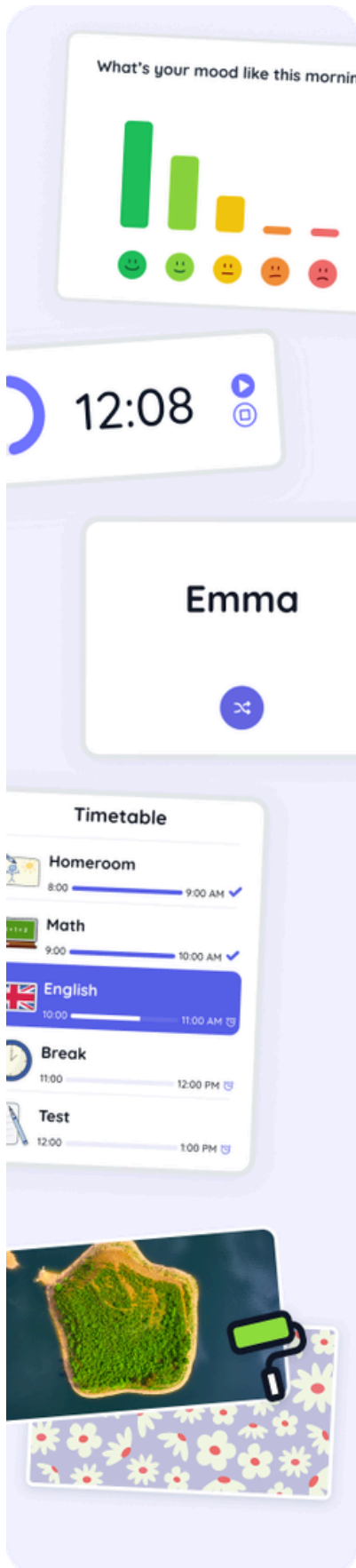
When you launch Classroomscreen, you will arrive at the widget screen to find 25 different widgets that support all of your classroom activities!

To add a widget to your screen:

- Click on its icon in the widget bar.
- It will pop onto your screen.

When a widget appears on your screen, a toolbar will float above the widget, and you can hover over the icons to get descriptions (aka tool tips) of actions you can take.

Good organization is central to teaching, so when designing Classroomscreen, we prioritized storage! There is no limit on how many screens you can have as a Pro user, so knowing how to organize your screens effectively is super important.

Your Dashboard is where you can see all your screens and organize them according to your needs. You can access your dashboard by clicking on the 'Home' icon in the upper left-hand corner of your screen. You can also access your name lists, backgrounds and other important settings here.

Folders

Dashboard > **folders** > screen decks > screens

If you have a Basic account, you'll only see the screen deck you've created in the 'All screens' tab. If you have a Pro account, you can create folders to store your saved screen decks in.

Folders are often used to group screens according to subject or year group.

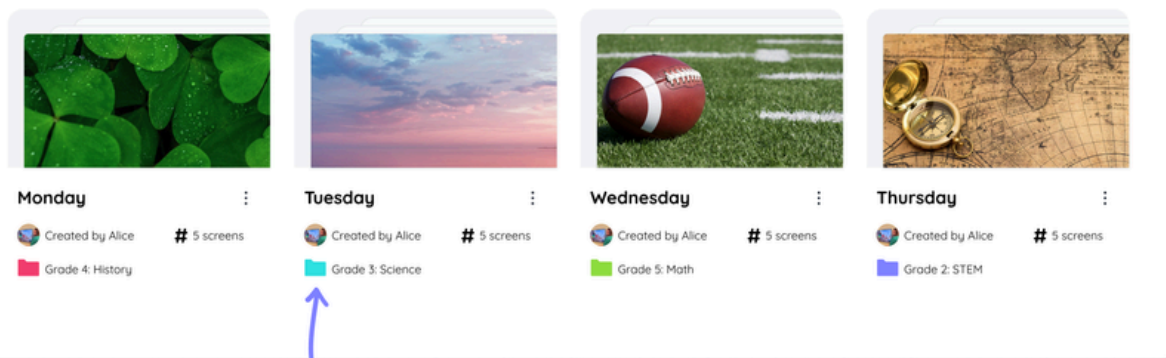

Screen decks

Dashboard > folders > **screen decks** > screens

Screen decks are a series of screens that you can easily flick through. If you choose to ‘Pin’ a widget, it will stay visible in the same spot across all screens within that screen deck.

There are many ways to use a screen deck, but a common approach is to create one for each day and store all your screens for that day in the same deck.

You can also assign each screen deck a different color to stay organized, and move screens between decks simply by dragging and dropping.

Screens form the foundation of Classroomscreen — the name says it all! There are two ways to create a new screen: you can add one from the dashboard by selecting ‘Create new screen’ within the Dashboard, or directly from an existing screen.

To create a brand-new screen, simply press the right arrow in the bottom-right corner of your current screen.

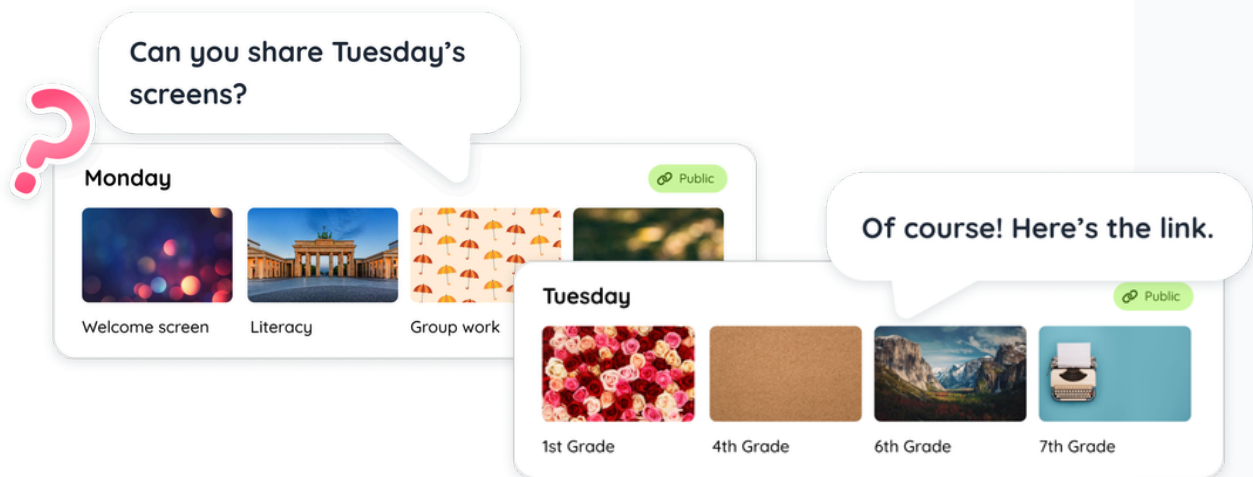
💡 **Tip:** You can also navigate between screens through a handy keyboard shortcut: CNTR + ENTER.



Sharing screen decks

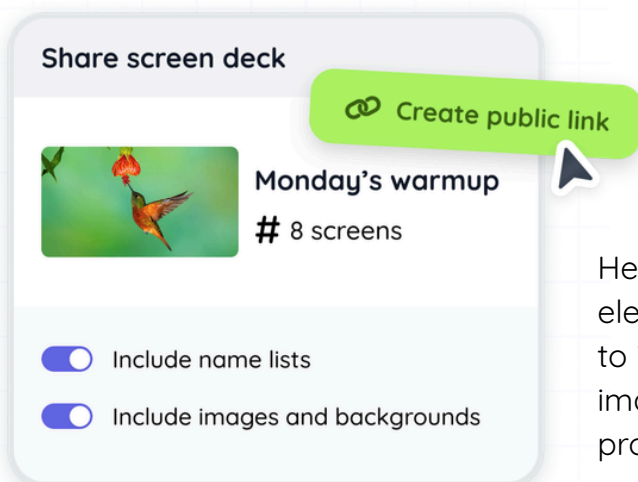


Sharing your screens ensures that students, teachers, and administrators can access your work whenever they need it. You can manage sharing from different areas in your account, choose what content to include, and modify or disable the permissions of the screen decks you've shared.



How to share your screen decks with others

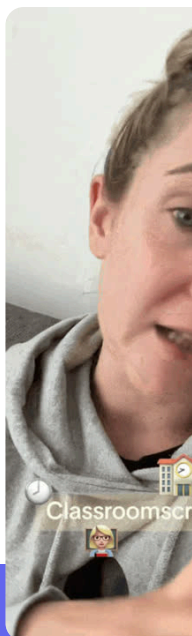
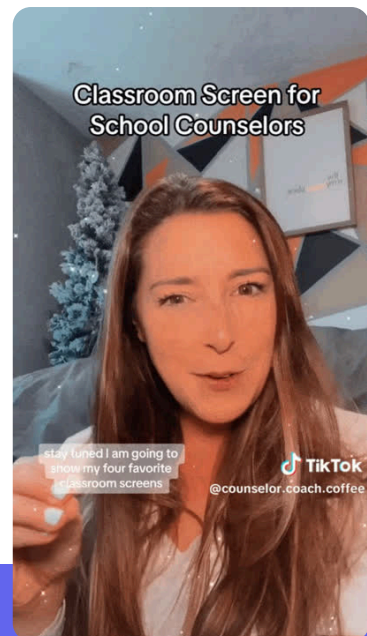
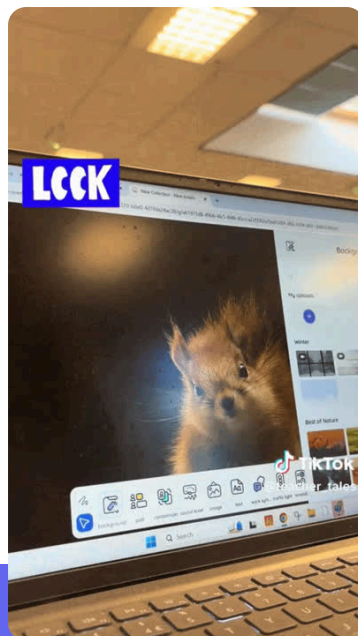
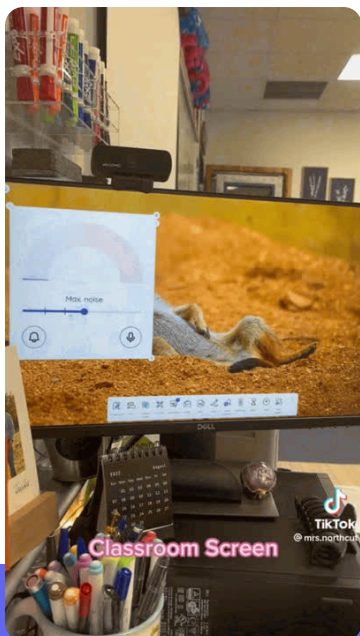
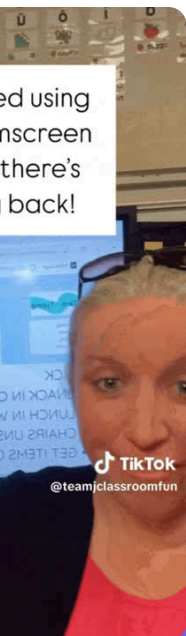
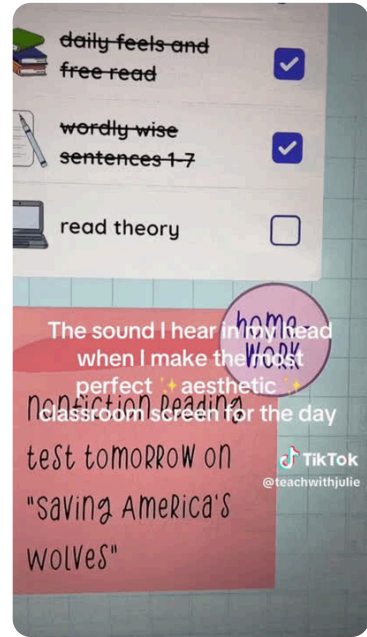
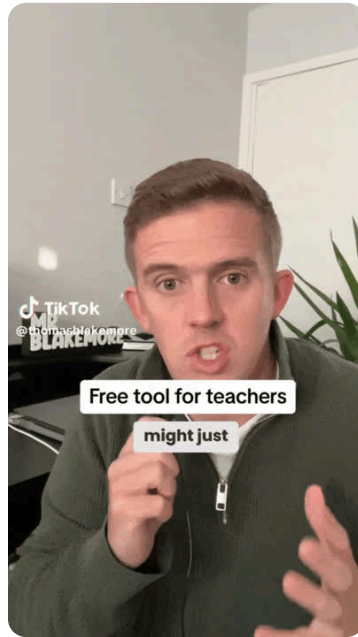
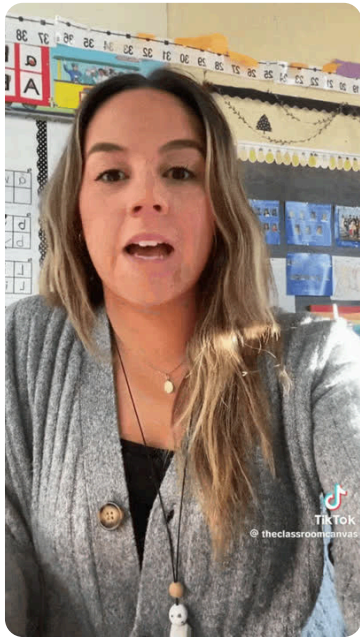
You can share a screen deck through a link, which can be generated in two ways; from the Dashboard or from within a screen. Clicking 'Create public link' from either location will prompt this pop-up to appear.



Here, you can decide which elements to share. Use the toggles to include or exclude name lists, images, and backgrounds to protect privacy.
